 - a. Friendship Park Project Funding!
 - i. We gor a grant! Big News! The City of Bethlehem applied for several grants to support the cost of the Friendship Park renovations. We just received word that the city was awarded \$747,966.00 from through the National Park Service's Outdoor Recreation Legacy Partnership (ORLP). See the announcement here: \$58.3 million in grants for park and recreation projects
 - ii. HRG is almost done with the construction documents. They are making some final adjustments before getting the items finalized for bidding. Our NPDES permit remains under review with the state. It should be issued end of May/early June. Once we have the permits the project can go out to bid. The goal is still to have construction start later this summer.
 - b. Free Little Library
 - Installation Locations: PW will be installing the free little libraries that were purchased at the end of last year in April/May. One will be located in Elmwood Park and one will be near the monocacy creek in Johnston Park.
 - c. Pet Waste
 - i. Approved Installation Locations & Maintenance

However, in the meantime we were able to find a third party service provider that will pick up dog-waste and service dog waste stations (cans/bags).
